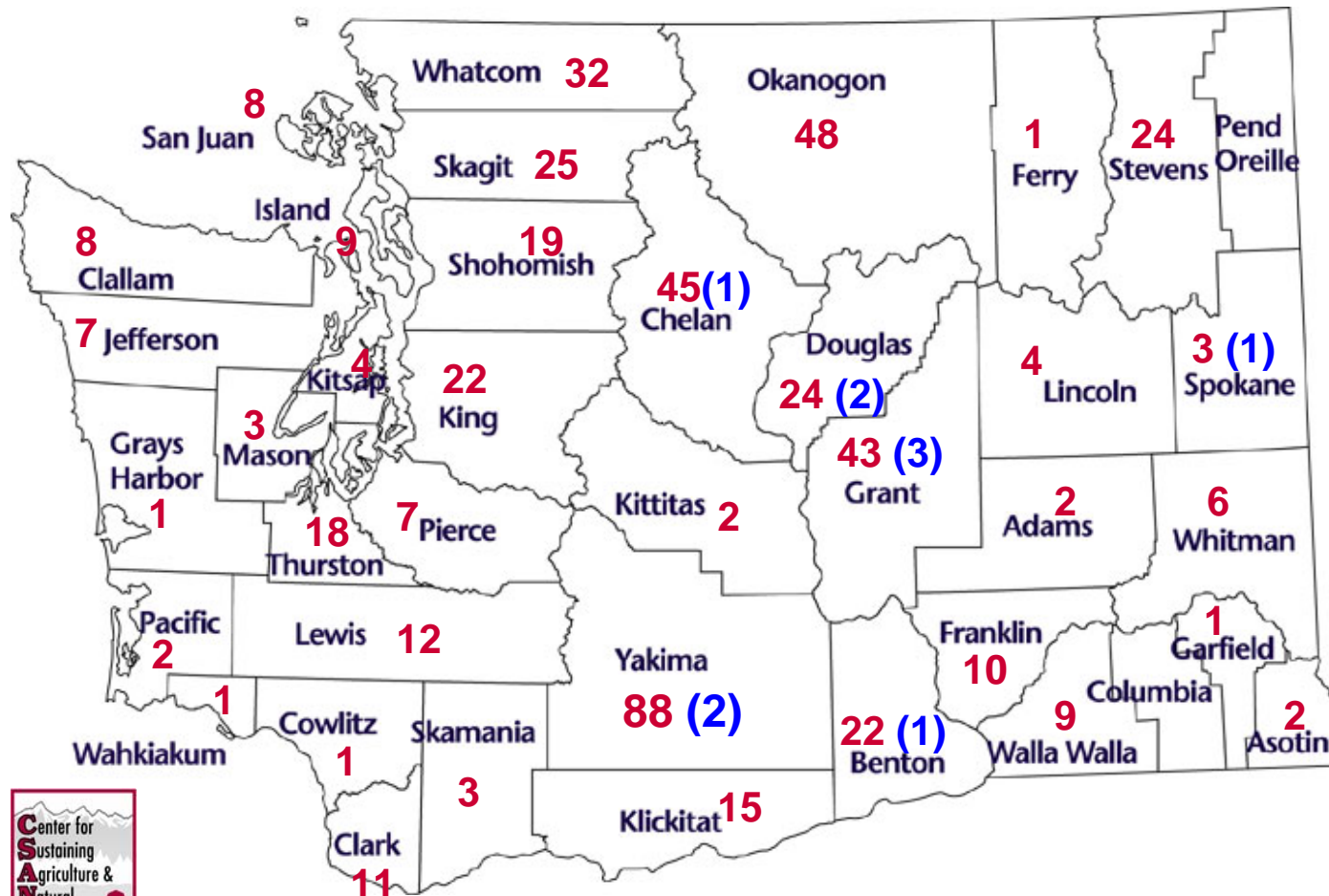


# Estimated number certified farms in Washington – 2004

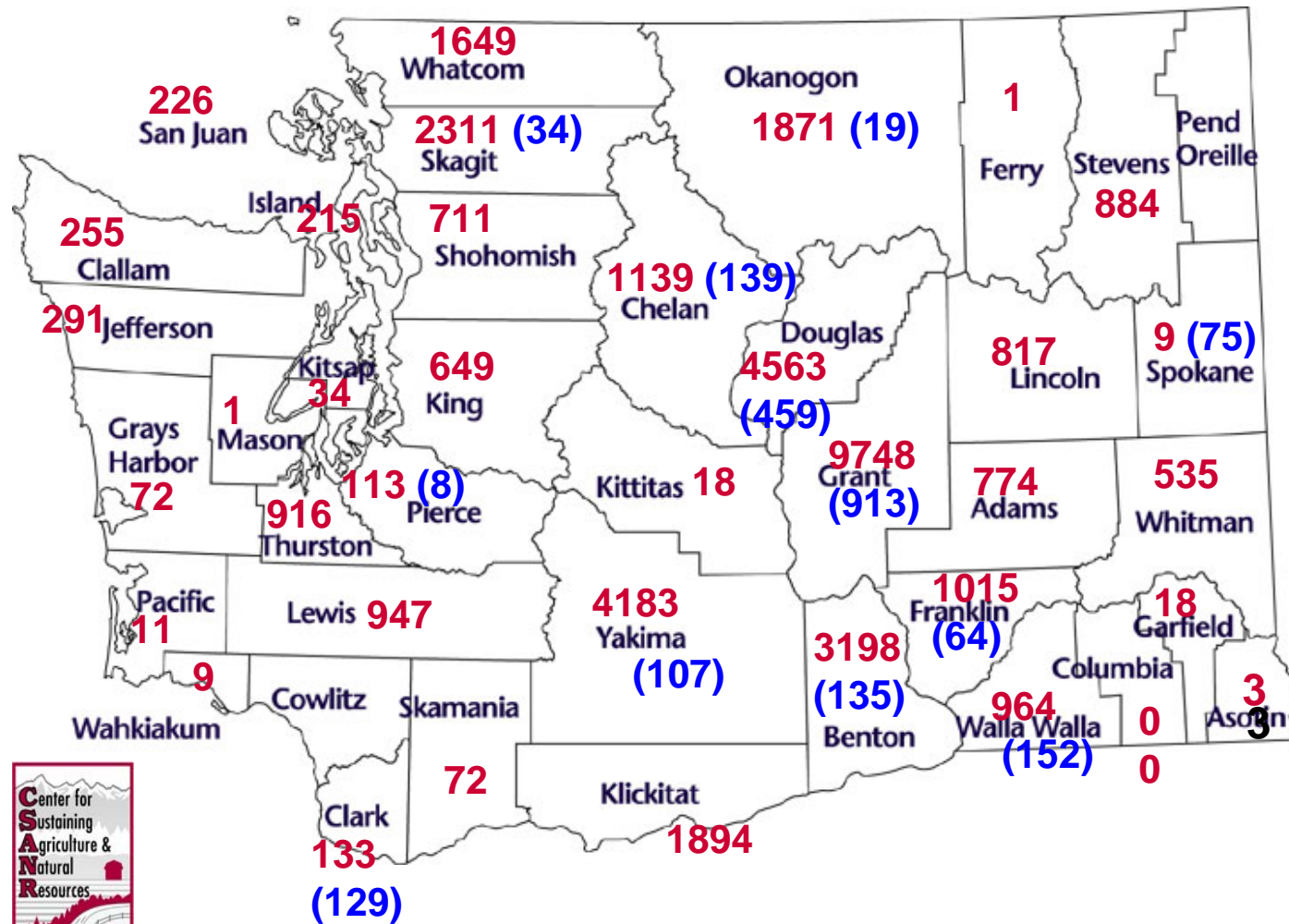
Eastern WA
