Farmers Market & Local Foods Promotion Program Grants Webinar & Workshops

WSU is partnering with USDA to provide training to help applicants develop and successfully submit competitive proposals to the *Farmers Market and Local Foods Promotion Programs*.

Farmers Market Promotion Program (FMPP) supports farmers markets and other direct producer-to-consumer activities.

Local Foods Promotion Program (LFPP) supports enterprises that aggregate, store, distribute and process local and regional food.

In 2014, 12 projects in WA received grants from \$25,000 to \$100,000, totaling \$792,650 in all.

The Request for Proposals (RFP) was released on March 16 and the proposals are due on **May 14, 2015**.

The webinar and workshops are open to all individuals and groups seeking to better connect agricultural producers and consumers through local food systems.
